The event marks the conclusion of the [MARCHE2Resilience \(M2R\) project](#), coordinated by the Regione Marche, which aims to increase the territory’s resilience to climate change by promoting collaboration between the Region and local authorities and involving civil society.

Throughout the day, the results of the project and the activities carried out by the Region in the field of climate adaptation will be presented, in light of the [Regional Plan of Adaptation to Climate Change \(RPACC\)](#) and sustainability, in line with the [Regional Strategy of Sustainable Development](#).
